FUNERAL OF MRS. POLLARD

We regret to record the death, which occurred on Thursday, 15th, at Orkney-House, John-Street, of Mrs. **Emily POLLARD**, widow of the late Alderman H. H. POLLARD, J.P., C.C., who pre-deceased her just over a year ago. The deceased lady who was 85 years of age, was amongst the oldest residents of Ryde, and during the life of her esteemed husband she was his devoted help-mate in their many religious, temperance and other matters with which he was identified, especially in connection with the Wesleyan Church. She has scarcely left the house since his death and had been in failing health for some time. Much sympathy has been expressed with the family in their bereavement.

The funeral took place at the Cemetery on Monday and was of a simple character. The Rev. A. TRIGGS (late Wesleyan Superintendent Minister) carried out the burial service and the mourners comprised Professor and Mrs. POLLARD (London) and Mr. and Mrs. E.W. POLLARD (sons and daughters-in-law), and the Misses S. E. and M. E. POLLARD (daughters), There was a number of floral tokens.
