FORMER FOOTBALLER'S DEATH

The vicar (the Rev H. E. GIBSON) officiated at the funeral at Holy Trinity Church on Saturday, of Mr. **Harry GLADDIS**, aged 68, of 28 Southfield-gardens, who died at his home on Wednesday week.
