### DEATH OF MR. A. S. GUY

The death occurred on Thursday week of Mr. **Arthur Stanley GUY**, aged 56, of 41 Salter's-Road. He was a bricklayer, and retired three years ago on health grounds from the employment of Messrs. G. WHITE and Sons. He served with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Worcestershire Regiment in the first world war, and was a sufferer from poison gas. He leaves a widow, two sons, and four daughters.
