MR. H. CASTLE

Founder of the Ryde business that bears his name, Mr. **Harry CASTLE** passed away on Monday at his home, "Lewington," Melville-street, Ryde, after a long illness.

A widow, one daughter (Miss E. M. CASTLE), and two sons (Mr. E. H. CASTLE and Mr. A. S. CASTLE) are left.

Born at High Wycombe Mr. CASTLE was a member of a family of craftsmen, who still carry on their chair manufacturing tradition. Mr. CASTLE came to Ryde as an employee for a local firm, but within a short time he started his own business in the High-street.

For many years Vice-President of the Isle of Wight County Bowling Association, Mr. CASTLE played for the Island against the touring South African team, when they visited Ryde.

Mr. CASTLE has played for the County of Hampshire, and he was for some years treasurer of the Ryde Indoor bowling Club. The funeral takes place at the George-street Baptist Church on Saturday.
