SUDDEN DEATH OF A LITTLE GIRL

Much sympathy has been exhibited for Mr. and Mrs. TEAGUE, who have lost their little girl, **Pearl**, under peculiarly mournful circumstances. The child was running about as usual on Saturday, but was taken ill in the night and died in a few hours. Croup is stated to have been the cause of death.
