SUDDEN DEATHS

Two cases of sudden death in Ryde were reported to the Deputy Coroner for the Island (F.A. JOYCE, Esq.) on Saturday..... The other was that of a cab-driver named **John WETHERICK**, who resided alone at a cottage in Nelson-street. It seems that he consulted Dr. PRESTON at about 8.30 on Friday evening, when the Doctor prescribed for him, telling him that he had heart disease. He went to Mr. WILSON the chemist's in Cross-street, and had the medicine made up. Later on Dr. PRESTON found the man sitting on a window sill at Mr. SCOVELL's and had him removed to the Melville Inn. Finding his condition serious, a bus was sent for to convey the man to the Infirmary, but he died before he got there and his body was removed to the mortuary. In neither case was an inquest held.

The funeral of Mr. WETHERICK took place on Wednesday at the Cemetery, where great respect was shown to him by many of his friends, including Mr. STEVENS, his late employer, and the members of the Garfield-road Bible Class, which the deceased attended.

Wreaths were sent by a number of friends.
