NB: After the death of **Louisa**, George went on to marry in 1869, Ellen Anne WAVELL from Ryde, and then moved to Caister in Norfolk. The family were found on the 1871 census, George was once again a Hotel Keeper and Licensed Victualler at the White Hart Hotel, with his new wife Ellen and three children. Two of those children are below and it is believed that **Louisa** was their mother.

As the main events took place between the census, ie the marriage of George & Louisa (at Clerkenwell 1862, and the index gives two female surnames), as yet we cannot ascertain whether Louisa's maiden name was WATERS or HAWES, The probability of it being WATERS is favourable, as no HAWES can be found anywhere near the right age.
