

DEATH OF GEORGE KIRKPATRICK DALY

A great grief has befallen General Sir Henry DALY in the loss of his third son Lieut. Henry Kirkpatrick DALY, of the Bombay Staff Corps and Central India Horse, who died in India on the 21st inst., at the age of 28 years. The deceased was an officer of high promise, and bade fair to worthily uphold the distinguished reputation of his gallant father. His death in the very flower of his years is a loss to the service, as well as a crushing personal bereavement, and the deepest sympathy will be universally felt for Sir Henry DALY and the other members of the family in the great sorrow with which they have been so unexpectedly visited.
