DEATH OF MR. T. J. CARTER –

The death of Mr. **Thomas Joseph CARTER**, a well known tradesman, occurred at the County Hospital on Wednesday. Mr. CARTER, who was 51, was taken to hospital on Sunday. A native of Ventnor, he assisted his mother in carrying on a greengrocer's business at 180 High-street, and at her death 17 years ago became proprietor. He was formerly a prominent member of the Rowing Club and during the war saw service in Palestine. On the appeal for National Service volunteers he became a special constable. He was a quiet, kindly nature, and was held in high regard. His death at a comparatively early age is much deplored. Much sympathy is felt with his widow, son and two daughters. The funeral takes place this (Saturday) afternoon at the Parish Church.
