FUNERAL OF THE LATE MR. T. C. WATSON

The funeral of Mr. **T. C. WATSON**, of Cliff House, Dover Court, Harwich, the owner of the *Kriemhilda*, who died so suddenly on board that yacht last week, were interred in the Ryde Cemetery on Saturday morning. The remains of the deceased were enclosed in a splendid coffin of pollished oak, with elaborate brass mountings. The plate bore the following inscription:

Thomas Colclough WATSON, Died, July 2nd, 1890, Aged 67 years.

The service at the grave was performed by the Rev. -- STOOKS, of Blackwater, Hants, the nephew of the deceased. The chief mourners were the two Misses WATSON, Mr. Gerald WATSON (nephew), Rev. W. R. WATSON (brother), Miss WATSON, Mr. J. WATSON, Mr. --- WATSON (brothers). Rev. STOOKS, Mr. H. WATSON, Mr. WOOLCOMBE, Mr. HUTTON, Mr. J. R. FRANKS (steward). Captain COOK and the crew of the *Kriemhilda* also followed. The coffin was covered with a number of splendid wreaths.

Messrs. COOMBES carried out the arrangements in their usual efficient style.
