## **INQUEST ON AN INFANT**

On Saturday afternoon, Acting Coroner of the Isle of Wight, held an inquest at the Star Hotel, Ryde, touching the death of the male child of Ernest Alfred BEAZLEY, 16 Bedford-place. The mother was attended by Mrs. COX, a certified midwife, who deposed that the child was weakly at birth, and the following morning she advised Mrs. BEAZLEY to give it some cornflour and milk, which she did, but the child died on the Friday night. Dr. A. WOODWARD deposed that there were no marks of violence and agreed with the evidence given by the midwife. The jury returned a verdict that death was due to the Visitation of God.

The above unnamed male child age 2 days, was buried Jan 29<sup>th</sup> 1900 at Ryde Cemetery.
