### DEATH OF MR. W. GABELL

By the death of Mr. **W. GABELL**, printer and stationer, of Union-street, on Friday, a well known form has been removed from our midst. The deceased began business here some half a century since, and he always took great interest in all that concerned the prosperity of the place and of its people.

The funeral took place at the Cemetery on Tuesday afternoon, the Vicar of Holy Trinity (the Rev. A. J. WADE) officiating.
