### **FUNERAL OF MRS. LUSTY**

The body of Mrs. **LUSTY**, the widow of Anthony LUSTY who was for some years a resident of Ryde, was brought to Ryde for interment, on Tuesday, from Pound Cote, Morton, Hampstead, South Devon.

The first part of the burial service was conducted at All Saints' Church, and thence to the family grave at Ryde Cemetery. The coffin was of polished elm and bore the inscription Sarah Lavinia LUSTY, died 27th September 1918, aged 68.
