Our obituary records the death of Mr Thomas Harbey of Trafalgar-road, foreman to Mr W C Way, builder. This is the second case of death from injuries received in the recent van accident. On Friday lockjaw came on, and a about 2pm on Sunday he expired. As to the two men who now lie suffering from the effects of the accident, Charles Salter, driver and owner of the van, lies in a dangerous state, and John Harvey of Field-place, is in a fair way of recovery.
