ATTEMPTED SUICIDE –

On Friday night of last week, Miss **Rosa STAMP**, residing with her widowed mother at Kingsley, Victoria-street, was discovered with a serious injury to her throat, supposed to be self-inflicted with a table knife. Dr. KENNEDY was at once called in and after stitching up the wound he had the sufferer removed to the Alexandra Home. Miss STAMP, it is stated, had been in a low and depressed state for some little time past, and yesterday it was deemed expedient to remove her to the Isle of Wight Asylum.

DEATH:

Rosa STAMP died from exhaustion caused by acute melancholia on April 19th 1915 at the Lunatic Asylum, Carisbrooke aged 46.
