Melliee Esq. Right J of M by writhe the consent of her father Edward George Housell
doth put her self apprentice to Arthur Debenham, Photographer of 28 Horse St. Right Jt.
 to serve his Art and with him after the Manner of an Apprentice to serve from the 25 day of May 1888



into the full Endowed Term of four Years from thence next following to be fully complete and ended During which Term the said Apprentice her Master justly shall serve his words keep his lawful commands every where wholy he sh^e shall do no damage to her said Master nor so to be done of others but to her. Never shall tell or forthwith give warning to her said Master of the same w^{ch} shall not waste the goods of her said Master nor lend them unlawfully to any sh^e shall not contract Matrimony within the said Term nor play at Cards or Dice Tables or any other unlawful game whereby her said Master may have any loss with his own goods or other during the said Term without licence of her said Master sh^e shall neither buy nor sell sh^e shall not haue Taverns or Playhouses nor abowther w^{ch} off from her said Master nor service day or night unlawfully but in all things as a faithful Apprentice sh^e shall behave herself towards her said Master and all his during the said Term And the said Master to be hereunto boundly agrees to pay his said apprentice by term of year for w^{ch} sh^e shall be content during the first year, of five shillings per week during the second year of seven shillings & sixpence per week during the third year, & of ten shillings per week during the fourth & last year of the same.
