SUDDEN DEATH –

The death of an old lady named **SIMCOX**, aged over 80, who had been lodging at Eversleigh, Arthur-street, took place rather suddenly on Friday. She had not had a medical man for about two years, but as she had been unwell for a day or two, her landlady on Friday sent for Dr. PRESTON. Before the gentleman's arrival she passed away.
