MRS. E. J. WHITE –

A lifelong member of Ryde Methodist Church, Mrs. **Emma Jane WHITE** of 29 Daniel-street, Ryde, died on Friday at her home. She was 85. A native of Haylands, she lived the first 40 years of her life at St. Michael's-avenue, formerly known as Church-street. Her husband, Mr. A. WHITE, died 40 years ago. Mrs. WHITE is survived by two sons and a daughter. The funeral service took place at Ryde Methodist Church yesterday conducted by the Minister, the Rev. T. J. FOINETTE. Interment was at Ryde Cemetery.
