MRS. E. J. WEST –

An esteemed and respected resident of Ryde for many years, Mrs. **Emily Jane WEST** passed away at Braunton, Nettlestone, recently at the advanced age of 77. Mrs. WEST had suffered ill-health for the past sixteen years, being confined to her bed for the last four years. A widow of the late Mr. K. H. WEST, she was a native of Ryde and had lived in the district practically the whole of her life. She was living at 94 Church-street, with her daughters, Mrs. E. L. TURNER and Mrs. BLACKSHAW, at the time of a night enemy air raid in 1941. The home was damaged, and, with her daughters, Mrs. WEST went to Nettlestone to live.

The Rev. Father LION officiated at the funeral at St. Mary's (R.C.) Church, Ryde, last week. The interment was in the Ryde Cemetery.

The mourners were Mr. G. J. WEST, Mr. W. WEST, and Private P. WEST, C.M.P. (sons), Mrs. G. J. WEST, Mrs. W. WEST, and Mrs. P. WEST (daughters-in-law), Mrs. W. RICHARDSON (niece) and Miss F. JONES (friend). Private W. E. BLACKSHAW, Royal Artillery, and Mrs. BLACKSHAW (son-in-law and daughter) were unable to attend. Several beautiful floral tributes were placed on the grave.

NB: It was noted that although the newspaper said Mrs WEST was widow of K.H.WEST, she actually married G.H.WEST.
