OBITUARY

The death took place somewhat suddenly on Saturday of Mr. **Charles James BEAZLEY**, of 35 High-street, Oakfield. Mr. BEAZLEY, who was a labourer employed by the Ryde Gas Company, left his work early on Saturday morning and had boarded a steamer for Portsmouth to see the football match at Fratton Park when he suddenly collapsed.
