THE FUNERAL

... of the late Mr. H. V. CARTER, who died on Saturday , after a long illness, took place on wednesday, the Rev. D. A. DAVIES officiating. The mourners were Mrs. CARTER (mother), Mr. F. CARTER and Mr. L. CARTER (brothers). Among those also present were the Mayor of Ryde (Ald. G. A. BLACKALL, J.P.) Messrs. W. R. TAYLOR, H. G. JOLLIFFE, A. DRAKE, and J. JONES. The coffin bore the inscription: "**Herbert Vale CARTER**, died April 6th, 1912, aged 40." Messrs. COOMBES carried out the funeral arrangements. Mr. CARTER was a native of Ryde, and was at different times proprietor of the Queens and Castle Hotels. In his younger days he was an enthusiastic Volunteer and also took part in the performances of the Ryde Amateur Dramatic Society with much success.
