DEATH OF MR. E. G. HOUNSELL

The death occurred on Tuesday, at Flora Cottage, Melville-street, of Mr. **Edward George HOUNSELL**, who had reached the great age of 91. Born at St. Heliers, Jersey, he came to the town as a boy, and for many years followed the occupation of a cabinetmaker, first with Messrs. MARVIN and afterwards with Messrs. COOMBES. He was the second oldest member and late trustee of the Loyal East Medina Lodge of Oddfellows. The funeral took place yesterday, the first part of the service being held at the Congregational Church, the Rev. Palmer LEWIS officiating.
