OBITUARY – MRS. E. CHIDWICK

A lifelong resident of Ryde has passed away with the death of Mrs. **Edith CHIDWICK**, of Flat no. 1, Leslie House, The Strand, Ryde, at the age of 66.

Born in 1870, at Elmfield, Ryde, she had never left the district for any length of time, and her quiet disposition had made her a wide circle of friends, which gradually time had lessened, until, of later years, there were but few left.

The funeral took place on Tuesday at Holy Trinity Church, the Rev. R. J. FORSE officiating. In accordance with the wishes of the late Mrs. CHIDWICK, the ceremony was as simple as possible.
