DEATH OF MRS HAYCO

We regret to announce the death of Mrs. **Alice Annie HAYCO**, wife of Mr. H. S. HAYCO, after 10 days illness, at 7 Dover-street, on Thursday week. She was the third daughter of the late Ald. Isaac BARTON and a sister of Ald. John I. BARTON, both former mayors. Most of her married life was spent away from the town, but she settled here again about seven years ago. Sincere sympathy is felt with her husband and sisters in their loss. The funeral service in All Saints' Church on Tuesday was conducted by the Rev. F. H. ROLPH. The mourners were Mr. H. S. HAYCO (husband), Mr. and Mrs. H. P. CHIVERTON (brother-in-law and sister), Mrs. BROWNSDON (sister), Miss WILLIAMSON (nurse), and Mrs. ALEXANDER (maid). Messrs. John, Patrick, and Robert BROWNSDON (nephews) were prevented by war duties from attending. The interment was in the Cemetery and the flowers included a token from the East Medina Chapter of Freemasons.
