OLD INHABITANT'S DEATH –

A much respected inhabitant, Mr. Job KING, passed away on Thursday week at Myrtle Cottage, Bettsworth-road, age 92. He was a member of an old Island family. He came to Ryde in the early seventies and for a long time was gardener to the late Sir John and Lady LEES, at Beechlands, Dover-street. Subsequently he did jobbing gardening until he was 80. He had been a member of the Foresters for 70 years and was a member of High-street Methodist Church and of the Conservative Association. He leaves a son and two daughters, his other son, Sergt. Arthur KING, died of wounds sustained at Gaza in the last war. The funeral was on Monday, the first part of the service being conducted at the house by the Rev. W. Bramwell HOWARD. The mourners were Mr. W.H.KING (son), Mrs. E.BALL (daughter), C.S.M. and Mrs. E.J.GATRALL (son-in-law and daughter), Mrs. W.H.KING (daughter-in-law), Mr. G.H.KING, Ventnor (nephew), Miss P.KING (grand-daughter), Mrs. E.LOCKYER (niece), Mr. and Mrs. F.GEARY (nephew and niece), Mrs. O.DAISH, and Mrs. T.F.SHEATH, Seaview. Miss M.GATRALL (grand-daughter) was prevented by illness from attending. Messrs. C.LANGDON and Son were the undertakers.
