HALL, Mrs. HARDING, Mr. LOWE and family, Mr. P. W. GILBERT, and Mr. and Mrs. and the Misses FLUX. Mr. G. GARNETT was prevented from attending by his own ill-health. Messrs. COOMBES carried out the funeral arrangements.
