DEATH OF MR. G. F. HARRINGTON, J.P.

We regret to announce the death of Mr. **G. F. HARRINGTON**, J.P. for the borough, at his residence, Hurdholm, Pellhurst-road, on Saturday. Deceased formerly took an ardent interest in the municipal affairs of Ryde. He was at one time Alderman of the borough, and filled the civic chair in 1869 and again in 1882. A dentist by profession, he was of an inventive turn of mind and patented, amongst other things, a method of sewer ventilation. The funeral took place on Wednesday at the Cemetery, the mourners being Messrs. G. F.HARRINGTON and C. J. HARRINGTON (nephews), and Mr. H. KNIGHT, a very old friend. The Rev. E. L. CRAWHALL officiated. The coffin was of polished elm with brass furniture, and bore the inscription: "George Fellowes HARRINGTON, died Feb, 2nd 1895, aged 83 years". Messrs. J. H. PERKIS and Son had charge of the arrangements. The Mayor (Ald. J. ELLERY), Alderman DASHWOOD, J.P., Councillors WHITTINGTON, J.P. (ex-Mayor), GROVES (deputy-Mayor), FOWLER, LOCK, HANSFORD, and POLLARD, J.P., and Mr. S. COCKS were present. A wreath was sent by Mr. C .J., Mrs., and Miss HARRINGTON, and by Mr. E.BUXEY.
