FUNERAL OF MR. C. LANGDON

The funeral of Mr. **Charles LANGDON**, of 13 Melville-street, took place on Saturday, the first part of the service being held in St. Thomas's Church, where the coffin had lain all night, The Rev. H. B. WORTHINGTON (incumbent) officiated, assisted by the Rev. W. H. COWPER-JOHNSON (deceased's son-in-law). The service was simple in character, the only music being played by the organist (Mr. C.
