DEATH OF MR. ARTHUR HACKSHAW -

One of the best known business men in Union-street for half a century, Mr Arthur HACKSHAW died at his home, 10 Yelf's-road, on Tuesday at the age of 76. Some 56 years ago Mr. HACKSHAW arrived from Marlow and set up in business as a hairdresser at 6 Union-street, and 14 years ago he transferred to more up-to-date and larger premises at No. 64, where he continued as the active head of the business until three years ago, when his health began to fail. In the earlier years he was an enthusiastic walker and cyclist. He was a member of the American Geographical Society and for a long period served as sidesman at the Parish Church. Much sympathy is felt with Mrs. HACKSHAW and her family. The funeral took place on Thursday, Canon A.CORY conducting the service at the Parish Church, where the men's choir chanted Psalm 23 and led the singing of "Abide with me." As the cortege left the church they chanted the Nunc Dimittis and the organist (Mr. W.L.REED) played "O rest in the Lord." The mourners were Messrs. G.V.H. and A.R.HACKSHAW (sons), Mesdames A.G. The Rev. J.OUTRAM officiated at Ryde Cemetery and there were many floral tributes. Messrs. WHEELER Bros. were the undertakers.
