DEATH OF MAJOR A. H. DABELL

Major Alexander Hugh DABELL, M.C., R.A., aged 80, of Vernon Lodge, Vernon Square, died on Monday at his home. Born at Blackgang, Major DABELL entered the Hampshire Yeomanry before the 1914-18 war. During that war he received a commission, won the Military Cross and was twice mentioned in despatches. He served in the Army of occupation in Germany for 18 months after the war and later entered the silk and velvet trade in London. In 1940 he rejoined the Army as an administrative officer until 1945, when he retired and returned to the Island. He was managing director of Messrs. Packs (now Pack & Culliford, Ltd.), from 1949 until 1959. Major DABELL was a member of Ryde Golf Club and the Ryde Club. A service at Holy Trinity Church on Thursday, conducted by the Rev. J. R. SHAW (vicar) preceded interment at Ryde Cemetery. Messrs. C. LANGDON made the arrangements.
