VICAR'S WIDOW

Mrs. **Edith Eveline DURHAM**, aged 90, of 7 Yelf's-road, died at the Royal I.W. County Hospital on Monday. Born in Newport, Monmouthshire, she came here when her husband, the Rev. Alexander C. DURHAM, was instituted and inducted vicar of St. Michael's, Swanmore, a position he held until his death in June 1944. While at St. Michael's, Mrs. DURHAM was enrolling member of the Mothers' Union branch. For many years she was county hon. treasurer of the Island girl guide movement, retiring about ten years ago. She leaves two sons, Dr. P. D. A. DURHAM and Lieut.-Commander M. H. B. DURHAM, both living in the town. The funeral yesterday (Friday) was followed by interment in her husband's grave at Ryde Cemetery. Messrs. LANGDON made the arrangements.
