## Alfred Charles linington A pioneer Ryde boatman

The death occurred at 15 Bellevue Road, early on Thursday morning of a well-known and highly esteemed resident, Mr Alfred Charles Linington, one

of the pioneer boat proprietors and a popular figure in the town.

Mr Linington had been ill with erysipelas five weeks before, but had partially recovered when complications set in, and he passed peacefully away in his 77<sup>th</sup> year. He had carried on the business of boat proprietor both on the shore and on the Canoe Lake for nearly half a century, and in former years was a prominent
