#### **THE FUNERAL**

The funeral of Miss **Alice Mary WRIGHT**, of Milford, Swanmore-road, daughter of the late Mr. Frank WRIGHT, who died on Monday week at the early age of 39, took place on Thursday week amidst many tokens of esteem.
