DEATH OF MRS. W.WATTS –

We deeply regret to record the death of **Mrs. W.WATTS**, who passed away at her residence. North View, Spencer-road, on Sunday morning, after a short illness. The deceased lady was very widely known and most highly esteemed by all who were honoured with her acquaintance. Sincere and widespread sympathy is felt for Mr. and Miss WATTS in their irreparable loss. The funeral was on Thursday afternoon.
