**MRS. A. M. ELEY**

Mrs. **Alice Mary (Jo) ELEY** passed over to the Higher Life after a long and painful illness on Wednesday. She was the widow of the late Mr. James ELEY, of Little Duxmour Farm, Havenstreet, who passed over in 1928. Mrs. Eley came from London to reside at Havenstreet about 11 years ago and whilst in the village became associated with the local Women's Institute, of which organisation she was treasurer for some time. She was highly spoken of by the members and her work there will be remembered for many years. She unfortunately had to give the work up in 1927 owing to indifferent health, and came to live at Mount House, George-street. She was aged 63.

The Rev. A. C. DURHAM (Vicar of St. Michael's, Swanmore) officiated at the funeral service which was held at the Cemetery on Saturday afternoon. The family mourners were Miss F. TAYLOR (sister), Mrs. Sidney TAYLOR and Mrs. H. MEADER (sisters-in-law), Mr. W. MALEKIN (brother-in-law), Mr. L. GREGORY (nephew), Mr. F. and Miss SOTHCOTT, of Southsea (cousins). Many of the deceased's friends, including a number from Havenstreet, were present at the graveside. There were 28 wreaths.
