FUNERAL OF THE LATE MR. T. ROE

The funeral of the late Mr. **T. ROE**, for many years postmaster of the Ryde district, took place on Tuesday morning. The funeral cortege was very plain and unpretending. Among those who testified their respect for the deceased by attending were Mr. T. DASHWOOD, J.P., Dr. JOHNSON, Mr. POLLARD of High-street, Mr. TUTTE (Oakfield), and Mr. DAWSON (Seaview). As many of the Post Office employés as could be spared (about 20), also joined in the procession, and walked two and two. The service at the grave was performed by the vicar (the Rev. A. POOLE).
