DEATH OF MISS E. M. PELLEW

38 Years A Buyer For Messrs. Pack's

A well known figure in Island business life and for 38 years a buyer for H. Pack & Co., Ltd., Union Street, **Miss Eva Marion PELLEW**, of Lind Street, Ryde, died at the I.W. County Hospital on Friday.

Although a Londoner by birth, born at Peckham, Miss PELLEW came to the Island immediately after serving her apprenticeship at Islington. She was employed by Denise's Union Street, before joining the staff of Pack's where she specialised in children's clothing. Her skill as a buyer was well known both on the Island and in London, where business often took her. Her friends, who included many of her customers, knew her as "Polly."

Miss PELLEW died after a short illness following a heart attack while at work.

The entire staff of Pack's together with directors attended the funeral service at All Saint's Church, Ryde, on Tuesday. The Vicar, the Rev. R.H. BASSETT, officiated and mourners included Miss W.G.
