OLD TOWNSMANS'S DEATH

An old and esteemed resident of Ryde passed away on Thursday in the person of Mr. Daniel ALLEN, of Lyndhurst, Winton Street, Ryde. Formerly of Hungerford, Berks, he came to Ryde many years ago and opened in business as a provision dealer at the bottom of Union Street. Subsequently (about thirty years ago) he acquired the Yarbridge Brewery from which he retired some eighteen or twenty years ago. Mr. ALLAN was a widely read man and was a most interesting conversationalist on a great variety of subjects. Scientific subjects had always a great attraction for him, particularly natural history. He was also a clever microscopist. In 1876 he became a member of the Ryde Town Council, on which he sat for seven years.
