Master Baker's Death. - The funeral service took place at Kingdom Hall, Daniel Street, on Thursday week for Mr **Alexander John ANDERSON**, aged 57, of Top Flat, Café Royal, who died at the Royal I.W. County Hospital the previous Wednesday. For the last seven years he had been employed as a master baker by H.G. JOLLIFFE and Sons, Ltd.

He had entered many mainland competitions. Born in West Ham, London, and educated at the local school, he had been a baker for all but five years of his working life. He was married at Romford, Essex, in 1938. During the last war he was in the Royal Navy and reached the rank of petty officer cook. Before moving to the Island in 1966 he was steward of the Oxford Liberal Club.
