### **MR. H. BARTLETT**

A former bootmaker and repairer who conducted his business in Garfield Road for some years died on Tuesday at his home, 39 Prince Street, Ryde, after several months' illness. He was Mr. Henry BARTLETT, the youngest son of the late Capt. Henry BARTLETT, of Cowes.

Mr. BARTLETT, who was 78, was born in Ryde and was a former member of the now defunct Liberal Club. During his later years he suffered from deafness and lived a quiet, retired life. His wife died in 1946. Three daughters survive him. The funeral takes place at Elim Chapel, Warwick Street, on Saturday at 10.45 a.m.
