MRS. E. BEDFORD

The death occurred on Monday at The Kyles, High Park Road, Ryde, of Mrs. Ellen BEDFORD. She was 87 years of age.

Mrs. BEDFORD was a well-known Ryde business woman, and kept a greengrocer's and general store in Monkton Street until eight years ago when she retired owing to ill-health. Her husband, the late Mr. E. J. BEDFORD, who was a well-known Island beekeeper, died about 15 years ago. For some time Mrs. Brodie SMITH has been caring for her, and it was in her house Mrs. BEDFORD died. She leaves a son.

The funeral took place on Wednesday at St. John's Church, followed by interment at Ryde Cemetery. The Rev. P. L. VAUGHAN conducted the service. Mourners included Mr. E. BEDFORD (son), Mrs. Brodie SMITH, Miss Sally SMITH. Mrs. E. BEDFORD (daughter-in-law) was unable to attend owing to ill-health.
