DEATH OF MAJOR. BOULCOTT.- We regret to record the death of Major BOULCOTT, which occurred with great suddenness at his residence, Queen's -road, on Saturday. The deceased, who some years back was well known as an amateur vocalist, had lately been suffering from a serious throat infection. He retired to rest on Friday as usual, but was found dead in his bed on Saturday morning, death being probably the result of apoplexy. Major BOULCOTT was a member of the Royal Victoria Yacht Club, and he had been acting as hon. sec. of the Amateur Art Society. The interment took place on Wednesday, when flags were flying at half mast at the Victoria Yacht Club-house, and the knell of the Parish Church was tolled. The Rev. A. POOLE officiated, and amongst those present were Col. TATTNALL, Mr. A. WOODWARD, M.R.C.S., Mr. H. JACOBS, Mr. W. E. RATCLIFFE, Mr. F. J. GREENING, Gen. Sir Samuel BROWNE, K.C.B., Capt.
