Death of Mr. W. T. BROOKER.---The death occurred at his home, 4 Butts Road, Haylands, on Saturday, of Mr. William Thomas BROOKER, aged 75. Mr. BROOKER was master of the Missions to Seamen yacht in the Solent for 42 years until his retirement owing to failing health seven years ago. In his younger days he was employed in Messrs. CHAPLIN and Co.'s luggage steamers. He was well known in the district for his many successes in horticultural shows, and was a former chairman of Haylands, Ashey, and Swanmore Horticultural Association.

The funeral took place at Ashey Cemetery on Tuesday. The Revs. M. O. H. CATON and C. E. PATERSON officiated. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs, C. BROOKER and Mr. and Mrs. G.
