The funeral took place at Christchurch Baptist Church on Saturday, followed by interment at Ryde Cemetery, of Mr. Charles Edward BROWN, of "Iona," Barfield, Ryde, whose death occurred the previous Wednesday. The Rev. E. J. WILLIS officiated.

Mr. BROWN, who was in his 83rd year, was a Londoner, but had lived with his son and daughter-in-law in the Island since 1933.
