Sudden Death: A member of a well-known family in Ryde, Mr. **Walter BUXEY**, of Pellhurst-Road, passed away suddenly on Saturday evening whilst seated in his chair. The deceased who was 65 years of age was a gardener and cow-keeper and was much respected. He had been in failing health for some time past and as he died from natural causes an inquest was not deemed necessary. The funeral takes place to-day (Thursday).
