#### **MR. W . B. CAMPBELL**

The funeral took place at the Ryde Cemetery on Wednesday afternoon last, the vicar of Ryde (the Rev. W. Neville MARTIN) officiating, of Mr. William Bruce CAMPBELL, who died at the I.W. County Hospital on the previous Saturday. He had previously been attending the out-patients' department with a swollen hand. He was 65 years of age and had been in business as a fruiterer and greengrocer since 1931 in Cross Street. Mr. CAMPBELL began his business career as a seedsman at Inverness and afterwards represented several well-known firms as a traveller.
