THE LATE MR. EDWARD CARTER. – The will (dated May 7th, 1874) of Mr. Edward CARTER, late of Thames Bank, Westminster, and Upton, near Ryde, who died on November 12th last, has been proved by George Carter EVELETH, Thomas Valentine SMITH and Edward CARTER (son of the deceased), the executors. The value of the personal estate amounts to over £82,000. The testator bequeaths £500, together with all his furniture, plate, pictures, linen, books, effects, horses, carriages, live and dead stock, and an annuity of £1,200 to his wife, Mrs Elizabeth CARTER. He also gives her a right of to reside during widowhood at Upton. Legacies to the amount of £20,000 each have been left upon trust for his daughters, Mary, Joanna and Georgina; and the testator has bequeathed £100 each to his executors, Mr. EVELEGH and Mr. SMITH. The residue of his real and personal estate is left upon trust to his son, Edward CARTER.
