Mr. H. E. CHAPPELL.- Mr. Harold Ernest Walter CHAPPELL, of 61 Alfred Street, died suddenly at his home last Tuesday evening, aged 52. A native of the Island, he joined the Royal Navy as a boy upon leaving school, and served for 25 years. Mr. CHAPPELL took part in the Dunkirk evacuation, and after leaving the Navy in 1949 became a British Railway porter at Ryde Pierhead, a position he held until the time of his death. He leaves a widow and one married daughter.

The funeral service took place on Saturday at Weeks Congregational Chapel when Pastor J. H. DIMMER officiated. Family mourners were: Mrs. H. E. W. CHAPPELL, widow; Mrs. P. ELLIS, daughter; Mr. J. CHAPPELL, brother; Mrs. W. SMYTHERS, Mr. and Mrs. W. NORMAN, sisters and brother-in-law. Interment was at Ryde Cemetery, when among the floral tributes were those from British Railways and the National Union of Railwaymen.

Messrs. H. V. TAYLOR and Son were the undertakers.
