THE LATE MISS COLLINS

Our obituary records the death of Miss **COLLINS**, George-Street, one of the oldest and most useful members of the Church of St. Michael's and All Angels, where she will be greatly missed.

The funeral took place on Monday afternoon. The coffin, of polished oak, was almost hidden by the numerous wreaths, &c., sent by various friends. It was conveyed in an open hearse to Swanmore Church, where it was met at the west door by the Rev. W.F.J. HANBURY (Vicar), the Rev. A. KERKHAM (Curate), the Rev. G. CROKE ROBINSON, and full choir. The opening sentences and the proper Psalm having been sung, the lesson was read by the Rev. CROKE ROBINSON, after which the hymn "For ever with the Lord," from hymns "Ancient and Modern," Nunc Dimittis was sung, and the Dead March in "Saul" was effectively rendered by the organist, Miss Margaret FOWLES. On arriving at the Cemetery gates the hymns "When our heads are bowed with woe," and "Christ will gather in his own," were sung. The Rev. A. KERKHAM, on arrival at the grave with the body, proceeded to read "Man that is born of a woman," &c., the Rev. W.F.J. HANBURY reading the concluding portion of the service. The hymn "For all the saints who from their labours rest," was then sung by the choir.

The funeral was conducted by Messrs. LANGDON.
