**FORMER RESIDENT'S DEATH.**- The death took place at Laycock, Wiltshire, on Friday week of Mrs. Ann Maria COLVERTON, widow of Mr. Francis COLVERTON, who was formerly in business in Ryde as a greengrocer and poulterer in the High-street. On the death of Mr. COLVERTON in 1899 deceased continued in the business until about 15 years ago, when she removed from the town to live with a married daughter. She was 73 years of age.

The remains were brought to Ryde on Wednesday for interment at the Cemetery in the same grave as her husband. The first part of the service took place at the Parish Church and was conducted by the Rev. C. BARKER.
